

DUNCAN–KRANZ CHORAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Conservatorium of Music at Avondale College of Higher Education offers the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship to a maximum of eight Avondale students who have a passion for music and a desire to sing with vocal ensembles Avondale Singers and The Promise. This scholarship is open to all students. The scholarship is awarded on merit to encourage and recognise worthy students with demonstrated aptitude in and commitment to music.

DETAILS

The Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship is worth \$500 per student per semester of study. The money for the scholarship comes from the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship Reserve, which is funded by the Duncan family.

Peter Duncan is founder and executive chairman of fluid transfer solutions company Pirtek. He is married to Valerie. Their parents, Charles and Sue Duncan and Alfred and Ethel Kranz, mentored people with promise—Charles and Sue sponsored young adults who wanted to complete tertiary education and Alfred and Ethel dedicated their lives to education, notably in Alfred's role as a Bible teacher at Avondale. Charles and Sue and Alfred and Ethel also provided support for the arts, particularly as performed by young Seventh-day Adventist musicians.

The Conservatorium of Music offers the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship to a maximum of only eight students at any one time. Applicants should, by no later than the first day of classes for each semester, contact the conservatorium to ask about the availability of the scholarship for that semester before completing the attached Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship Application Form. CONDITIONS

1. The Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship is available to any student at Avondale College of Higher Education subject to a successful audition.
2. If successful, the recipient of the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship must be a member of Avondale Singers and The Promise and commit to attending all required rehearsals and performances.
3. The Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship is not transferable.
4. The Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship cannot be deferred.
5. The Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship is awarded subject to the applicant meeting normal admission requirements and will be implemented once all academic enrolment procedures are finalised.
6. The semester value of the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship will be applied to the recipient's tuition account as at census day and cannot be redeemed for cash, in part or in whole.
7. If the conditions of the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship are no longer being met at census day, the scholarship will be discontinued.
8. Continuance of the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship for additional semesters of study is subject to the recipient continuing as an enrolled student at Avondale College of Higher Education, maintaining an academic status of good standing and by maintaining satisfactory status as a committed member of Avondale Singers and of The Promise.
9. All recipients should be of good standing in the community. Scholarships or part thereof may be revoked at the discretion of the Avondale College of Higher Education Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute.

DUNCAN–KRANZ CHORAL SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA

The Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship is granted on the basis of a successful audition and interview by the director of the Conservatorium of Music at Avondale College of Higher Education.

The audition and interview process is as follows:

1. Applicants should reserve an audition time by contacting the conservatorium—see “Conservatorium of Music Enquiries” for contact details;
2. Applicants will sing two contrasting a cappella pieces that showcase their vocal abilities;
3. Applicants must demonstrate their musicianship ability (sight singing and aural skills); and
4. Applicants will explain in an interview what the opportunity to be a member of Avondale Singers and of The Promise means to them personally.

Successful applicants will continue to receive the Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship for the duration of their tenure as members of Avondale Singers and The Promise.

APPLICATION DETAILS

Applicants are required to:

1. Complete the attached Duncan–Kranz Choral Scholarship Application Form.
2. Complete an audition and an interview.

AWARD PROCESS

1. Scholarship applications will be processed only for applicants who have also submitted an application to study at Avondale College of Higher Education.
2. Applications are to be submitted no later than enrolment in Semester One or Semester Two.
