

SCHOLARSHIPS

YOUNG MUSICIAN SCHOLARSHIP

Avondale University offers the merit-based Young Musician Scholarship to encourage a new student to explore their passion for music in a higher education context.

VALUE

The scholarship is worth \$2000. The successful applicant receives \$1000 per semester in the first year of a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Teaching course. Avondale will apply the money to the recipient's tuition account. The money comes from the Young Musician Scholarship Reserve, which two friends of Avondale Conservatorium fund. The friends value music education and have a history of supporting students through scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship is available to any new student aged 29 years or younger enrolling with a music major or specialisation in the first year of the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Teaching course.

CONDITIONS

Avondale awards the scholarship at census date subject to the recipients:

- Completing the Young Musician Scholarship Application Form;
- Meeting requirements for admission as an enrolled student in four units per semester (or, at the discretion of the Avondale Conservatorium Director, in less than four units) of the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Teaching course;
- Enrolling in the unit Solo Performance 1, and;
- Completing a successful audition with the Avondale Conservatorium Director.

CRITERIA

Applicants for the scholarship must:

• Demonstrate their passion for music.

Recipients of the scholarship must:

- Continue to meet the eligibility requirements;
- Maintain an academic status of good standing (for example, students enrolled in four units per semester must pass at least three, students enrolled in three units must pass at least two);
- Participate in a donor-recipient acknowledgement process initiated by Avondale, and;
- Maintain good standing in the community. (Scholarships may be revoked at the discretion of the Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute.)

Recipients of the scholarship cannot:

- Transfer or defer the scholarship, or;
- Redeem the scholarship for cash.
