

STUDENT FEES **2016**

DOMESTIC

A Domestic student is defined as:

- an Australian Citizen
- an Australian Permanent Resident
- a holder of an Australian Permanent Humanitarian Visa
- a New Zealand Citizen

All financial information quoted is in Australian dollars (AUD).

TUITION FEES (PER SEMESTER)

Typical tuition fees are:

COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACES:

The Australian Government provides Commonwealth Supported Places (CSPs), formerly called HECS, as a tuition fee subsidisation scheme. These are available to eligible Australian or New Zealand citizens, or to permanent humanitarian visa holders. At Avondale, CSPs are available to undergraduate nursing and education/teaching students and Master of Teaching (Primary/ Secondary).

CSPs have a reduced fee that is typically **\$3,076** for a standard* 4 units (24 credit points) per semester. Fees may vary according to the unit and number of units taken.

HIGHER EDUCATION COURSES (excluding Higher Degree Research Courses):

\$7,696 per semester for a standard* 4 units (24 credit points) per semester. Fees may vary according to the unit and number of units taken.

LAKE MACQUARIE CAMPUS
