

# Courses for North American Students

Avondale welcomes undergraduate students from the United States of America and Canada who wish to study for one semester, for a year or for a complete degree. All Avondale's degrees are registered on the Australian Government register of courses available for international students (CRICOS). North American students at Avondale are located on the Cooranbong Campus in the Lake Macquarie region which offers all Avondale degrees except the last five semesters of the Bachelor of Nursing.

## Credit transfer

It is recommended that North American students work with their academic advisors in North America using class descriptions ('subject synopses') from our website [[www.avondale.edu.au](http://www.avondale.edu.au)]. All Avondale subjects are available to North American students and these include subjects that may be transferred to their program of study as general education requirements, religion courses, electives or some of the major classes.

Students at Avondale College normally undertake a full-time load of four courses ('subjects' at Avondale) per semester, each of which is weighted as six credit points.

To facilitate credit transfer, Avondale offers a limited number of smaller 4 credit point courses (subjects). These are listed below. However, students who require additional courses of exactly 4 credit points in value, should contact the Vice President (Academic Administration) by e-mail at [vicepresident@avondale.edu.au](mailto:vicepresident@avondale.edu.au). Within available resources, special Individual Topic courses may be constructed for students who have particular curriculum requirements.
