NOTES:

Teaching Periods

The term **teaching period** replaces the term semester given that teaching periods are of different lengths and there are more than the standard 2 previously used with SRS.

Intensive Teaching Periods are for units in *on-campus* mode and normally are of 3 weeks duration. All the requirements of the course can be undertaken in the three week period but students may only take one intensive at a time. An overview of the intensive teaching period might look like the following:
