Key

Subjects are identified by a six character code (eg CH101.1). The first two characters indicate the subject area, eg: Chemistry. The next three characters are the subject's numeric code, with the first numeral denoting the level (1 indicates a 100-level subject). The last character following the decimal point denotes the semester in which the subject is offered (.1 denotes first semester, .2 denotes second semester, 1/2 means the subject is offered in both semesters, 1-2 means the subject carries across two semesters). The credit points for each subject are shown at the right of the subject title. Some subjects may have two codes.

Core subjects are indicated with CR codes.
