

A limited number of scholarships worth \$3,000 per annum for up to two years of study are available to teacher education students entering their third or fourth year of an undergraduate teacher education degree course, or the first or second year of a graduate-entry Bachelor of Teaching degree course at Avondale College. Successful applicants will also receive an additional \$3,000 payable during the first year of employment as a graduate teacher with Adventist Schools Australia, bringing the scholarship total to a maximum amount of \$9,000. Emphasis in allocation of scholarships will be given to students undertaking teaching majors in short supply.

ELIGIBILITY

- a) Any Australian student entering the third or fourth year of a four-year undergraduate teacher education degree course at Avondale College in 2011.
- b) Any Australian student entering the first or second year of a two-year graduate-entry Bachelor of Teaching degree course at Avondale College in 2011.

Note: A decision regarding the awarding of scholarships to BTch applicants may be deferred pending receipt of first semester grades and/or professional experience reports. Payments will be backdated for successful BTch applicants.

- c) The scholarship is available to both residential and non-residential students.
- d) The purpose of the AUC Education Scholarship is primarily to assist Avondale College students. However, if Avondale College is unable to offer training in a subject major required by the school system then the benefits of the scholarship may be extended to include students studying at other institutions.

CONDITIONS

- a) Applicants must:
 - i) Maintain full-time enrolment in the course approved for this scholarship;
 - ii) Demonstrate competence in meeting professional experience requirements.
- b) Once approved, any variation to the agreed study program can only be considered by the Scholarship Committee for the following reasons:
 - i) That any variation is deemed by the Scholarship Committee to be advantageous to the school system;
 - ii) Any variation must have the written support of the Avondale College Dean of the Faculty of Education.
- c) Any scholarship holder who fails to complete the agreed course of study at Avondale College will be liable to reimburse the fund for the full amount extended to them plus an administrative fee of \$1,000 for every year for which the student has been a recipient of the scholarship. However, a student may apply to the Scholarship Committee for consideration to waive this fee in special circumstances.
- d) Any scholarship holder who changes from the agreed course of study without the approval of the AUC Education Scholarship Committee (eg a change of major or minor) will be liable to reimburse the fund for the full amount extended to them plus an administrative fee of \$1,000 for every year for which the student has been a recipient of the scholarship.

- e) Any scholarship holder who fails to complete the agreed course of study due to failing grades will not be required to reimburse the fund, provided their application for exemption is approved by the AUC Education Scholarship Committee.
- f) Any scholarship holder who fails to complete the agreed course of study due to failing grades but who subsequently completes a degree program at another institution using credits from Avondale College, will be liable to reimburse the fund for the full amount extended to them plus an administrative fee of \$1,000 for every year for which the student has been a recipient of the scholarship.
- g) Recipients must sign a Bond Agreement requiring them to be available to teach for two years for the Seventh-day Adventist school system in Australia at any school nominated by the Teacher Placement Committee.
- h) Any scholarship holder who on completion of their course does not accept an appointment offered to them will be liable to reimburse the fund for the full amount extended to them plus an administrative fee of \$1,000 for every year for which the student has been a recipient of the scholarship. Recipients should be aware that they might be required to teach anywhere in Australia. However, every effort will be made to find a mutually agreeable location.
- i) In the unlikely event that the Teacher Placement Committee does not offer a teaching position by 31 December of the graduating year, the student is not bound to repay the scholarship fund for the amount extended to them.
- j) All monies owed to the AUC Education Scholarship Committee must be paid at such time as the default occurs.

CRITERIA

- a) The applicant must be a baptised member of the Seventh-day Adventist Church and regularly attending his/her local congregation.
- b) Scholarships are granted on the condition that a student undertakes a full-time study load each semester.
- c) Continuance of the scholarship is contingent upon passing all subjects. The scholarship will be suspended for the semester following the failure of any subject, and then reinstated and backdated following the next semester in which all subjects are passed.
- d) Scholarships cannot be redeemed for cash, in whole or in part.
- e) Applicants must be permanent Australian residents.

DEFERRAL

1. Requests for deferral will only be considered for taskforce volunteer positions involving a service component.
2. All requests must be presented to the AUC Education Scholarship Committee in writing and must also have the written endorsement of the Avondale College Life Committee and Faculty of Education before being presented for consideration.
