

CAMPUS LIFE SCHOLARSHIP 2010 RETURNING STUDENTS

Avondale offers up to two Campus Life Scholarships to returning students from Australia, New Zealand and the South Pacific region who can demonstrate through past activities and achievements their capacity to impact and influence Avondale's campus life in a positive way.

DESCRIPTION

The Campus Life Scholarship is worth \$3,000 (\$1,500 for each semester) for one year of study in any undergraduate or VTE course.

CRITERIA

Applicants must excel in at least one area that contributes to, enhances and impacts Avondale's campus life in a positive way: e.g. sportsmanship and sporting achievements, music and fine arts, spiritual mentoring, drama, worship leadership, volunteer support roles etc. Applicants must demonstrate how their activities and involvement have impacted on or added value to Avondale's campus life.

CONDITIONS

- 1 The scholarship is available to returning students who live in Australia, New Zealand or the South Pacific/Oceania region and who have citizenship or permanent resident status in any of the territories within this region;
- 2 A description of achievements in one or more activities must be provided;
- 3 The scholarship is available to students who can demonstrate an active involvement in one or more activities. The description of these activities should be provided with the application and countersigned by a supervisor of one of these activities;
- 4 Applicants must provide names and contact details of two referees;
- 5 The scholarship is not transferable;
- 6 The scholarship cannot be deferred;
- 7 The recipient can only receive benefit from one Avondale College or Avondale Foundation funded scholarship per year;
- 8 The scholarship is awarded subject to the applicant meeting normal admission requirements, and will be implemented once all academic enrolment procedures are finalised;
- 9 The semester value of the scholarship will be applied to the recipient's account at enrolment and cannot be redeemed for cash, in part or in whole;
- 10 If the conditions of the scholarship are no longer being met at census date, the scholarship will be discontinued;
- 11 The recipient must undertake a study load of at least 24 credit points (4 units) per semester. The scholarship will be discontinued the semester following one in which less than 24 credit points (4 units) are taken; however recipients may apply in writing if they encounter circumstances beyond their control, as determined by the Academic Registrar;
- 12 Continuance of the scholarship for the second semester of study is contingent upon satisfactory academic progress. All offers are made subject to confirmation of academic status.
- 13 All recipients should be of good standing in the community. Scholarships or part thereof may be revoked at the discretion of the Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1 Applicants are required to complete the attached Campus Life Scholarship application form;
- 2 Applications must be endorsed by an appropriate supervisor such as a lecturer, chaplain, student services director, youth leader, residence dean etc;
- 3 Applicants must submit written evidence of their activities and positive influence on the Avondale campus, countersigned by a supervisor of such activities;
- 4 Applicants must submit names and contact details of two referees;
- 5 The offer is made subject to all normal admission requirements being met and can be accepted once normal application procedures are complete.

AWARD PROCESS

- 1 Scholarship applications will only be processed for students who have also submitted an Avondale Application for Enrolment Form. - 2 First round scholarship applications will be processed in the first week of February and offers will be made within 7 days; second round scholarship applications will be processed in the first week of March and applicants will be notified within 7 days;
- 3 Applications are to be submitted by **31 January 2010**, or by **15 July 2010** for **returning** students commencing in second semester.
