STANLEY & DOROTHY PATERSON SCHOLARSHIP 2008**

AWARD DESCRIPTION

1. A scholarship award of \$4,000 shall be granted to a Bachelor of Business student each year.
2. The award will be divided into two parts and will be credited to the student's fee account during consecutive semesters in the academic year in which it is awarded. If the student fee account is fully paid the award may be withdrawn in cash.
3. The scholarship may be awarded to the same student more than once.
4. The scholarship is awarded on the advice of the Dean of the Faculty of Business and Information Technology and in the absence of suitably deserving students an award may not be granted.
5. Deferral of the award may be permitted with each deferral application being assessed individually.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. The recipient should be a full-time second or third year Bachelor of Business student on a regular academic load. For Bachelor of Business students completing a double degree their fourth year of study shall also qualify.
2. The award shall be based primarily on academic achievement, and in order to be nominated the student should exhibit above average academic performance in business and related subjects (credit or higher) in the year immediately preceding the award.
3. All else being equal, students with a greater number of business subjects will be given selection preference.
4. The student should be continuing for the full year of study in which the scholarship has been granted.
5. The student will exhibit diligence and a positive attitude to studies and where applicable, quality of service in work experience. The student's relationship to peers, lecturers and other Avondale College personnel will be taken into account. The student will show exemplary citizenship, presentation and professionalism. Failure to maintain these values may lead to forfeiture of the scholarship. The financial circumstances of the students will be taken into account when deciding between candidates of similar standing.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Dean of the Faculty of Business and Information Technology will review the academic performance of students according to the criteria set out below and bring a recommendation to a meeting of the staff in the Faculty of Business and Information Technology. A recommendation will be made to the Avondale Foundation.

NOTIFICATION AND PRESENTATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

As this award cannot be determined until all examinations have been graded the award is to be notified and presented as follows:

1. The student receiving the award is to be notified by mail during December.
2. The scholarship is to be presented at the Awards Forum early in first semester.
3. A representative of the Avondale Foundation or their designee to present the award.
