

THE A S & J W JORGENSEN SCHOLARSHIP 2010

Through the generosity of Pastor Alfred W Jorgensen, a former lecturer in the Faculty of Theology at Avondale, a trust fund has been established to provide financial assistance in the form of scholarships to theology students at Avondale. Applicants must be able to demonstrate eligibility on the basis of need. The number and amount of scholarships may vary from year to year depending on the funds released from the trust fund. In 2010 up to two scholarships valued at \$1500 per year may be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY

This scholarship is open to:

- any **third year** student applying for, or currently enrolled in, the Bachelor of Theology /Bachelor of Ministry degree; **OR**
- any **second year** student enrolled in the concurrent Graduate Diploma in Ministry/Graduate Diploma in Theology in 2010; **AND**
- **who intends to enter the preaching ministry of the SDA Church; AND**
- **is a baptised member of the SDA Church;**
- *this scholarship may be held in conjunction with an another Avondale Scholarship.*

CONDITIONS

- 1 Applicants must maintain full-time enrolment in a course approved for this scholarship;
- 2 Applicants must demonstrate competence in meeting ministerial placement requirements;
- 3 There is no residential requirement.

MANAGEMENT

The Avondale College Council (or its designee) will select students to receive the scholarship who meet the criteria of the scholarship. It may decline to select any student in any one or more calendar years. Each student selected need not be treated the same as any other student or students. The Council (or its designee) is not obligated to explain or give reasons for its decisions. Any questions arising as to the interpretation or application of these funds or both is to be resolved by the Council.

CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- 1 Be actively involved in his/her local congregation.
- 2 Be able to demonstrate financial need (see Appendix 1)
- 3 Have passed all units in the semester prior to their application if he/she is a continuing student.
- 4 Not redeem their scholarship monies for cash, in whole or in part.
- 5 Have obtained admission into Avondale College in order for the scholarship to be granted.
- 6 Be in good standing in the community. Scholarships or part thereof may be revoked at the discretion of the Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute.
- 7 Provide the names and phone numbers of two persons, such as a school teacher, pastor or employer, who are willing to provide a character reference.
- 8 In the eventuality that not all scholarships are awarded to applications received by the closing date specified on this form, a second round of applications will be considered if they are submitted by a date nominated by the Dean of the Faculty of Theology.

DEFERRAL

- 1 Only students in the third year of the Bachelor of Theology/Bachelor of Ministry course may defer a Jorgensen scholarship and any other students seeking to defer the scholarship must submit a written request for deferral to the Council or its designee, indicating the reason/s for requesting a deferral.
- 2 The scholarship may only be deferred for one year.
