

THE MCDOWELL THEOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

Through the generosity of Dr Gordon McDowell, a former principal of Avondale, a trust fund has been established to provide financial assistance in the form of scholarships to theology students at Avondale. Applicants must be able to demonstrate eligibility on the basis of need. The number and amount of scholarships may vary from year to year depending on the funds released from the trust fund. Up to four first-year scholarships valued at \$1500 per year may be awarded for the remainder of the course. In addition, up to four scholarships valued at \$1500 per year may be awarded to second-, third-, or fourth- year students for each year of the remainder of the course. One-off grants of up to \$1500 may also be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY

Any Australian or New Zealand student applying for or enrolled in either an undergraduate or Graduate Diploma in Ministry and/or Theology. This scholarship may be held in conjunction with an Avondale College scholarship.

CONDITIONS

- 1 Applicants must maintain full-time enrolment in a course approved for this scholarship;
- 2 Applicants must demonstrate competence in meeting ministerial placement requirements;
- 3 There is no residential requirement.

CRITERIA

- 1 Applicant must be a baptised member of the Seventh-day Adventist Church and actively involved in his/her local congregation;
- 2 Applicants must be able to demonstrate financial need;
- 3 Applicants must be permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand;
- 4 Scholarships are granted on the condition that a student undertakes 24 credit points (4 units) per semester;
- 5 Continuance of the scholarship is contingent upon passing all units. The scholarship will be suspended for the semester following the failure of any unit, and then may be reinstated following the semester in which all units are passed;
- 6 Scholarships cannot be redeemed for cash, in whole or in part;
- 7 Applicants must have already obtained admission into Avondale College in order for the scholarship to be granted;
- 8 All recipients should be of good standing in the community. Scholarships or part thereof may be revoked at the discretion of the Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute;
- 9 In some cases Avondale will contact a person who knows the applicant well. Applicants are to provide the name and phone number of a person, such as a school teacher, pastor or employer, who is willing to provide a character reference for them;
- 10 In the eventuality that not all scholarships are awarded to applications received by the closing date specified on this form, a second round of applications will be considered if they are submitted by a date nominated by the Dean of the Faculty of Theology.

DEFERRAL

- 1 Scholarships may not be deferred for the first year of study;
- 2 Students wishing to defer in subsequent years must submit a written request for deferral to the McDowell Theology Scholarship Management Committee, indicating the reason/s for requesting a deferral;
- 3 The scholarship may only be deferred for one year.
