

OUTDOOR RECREATION SCHOLARSHIPS 2010 NEW STUDENTS

DESCRIPTION

The Outdoor Recreation courses take one or two years (Cert III - one year, Diploma - one year) with comprehensive training in a variety of outdoor recreation skills. Avondale is pleased to offer ten scholarships in 2010 worth \$1,500 each.

CONDITIONS

- 1 Scholarships are only awarded to Australian or New Zealand students commencing the Certificate III or Diploma courses;
- 2 The scholarship is only available to a student who has not previously enrolled at Avondale except as per condition 3;
- 3 Outdoor Recreation students may apply for a scholarship for Cert III and again for the Diploma;
- 4 The Scholarship is available to students transferring from another College or Tertiary institution;
- 5 Applicants are asked to provide contact details of two referees. These can be the same as those on the Application for Enrolment Form;
- 6 The applicant will be interviewed in person or by phone by the Course Coordinator;
- 7 A statement of purpose will form a part of the application;
- 8 Continuance of the scholarship is contingent upon satisfactory course progress, citizenship and attendance;
- 9 The scholarship cannot be deferred;
- 10 The scholarship cannot be redeemed for cash, in whole or in part;
- 11 The recipient can only receive benefit from one Avondale scholarship in any one year;
- 12 The scholarship is awarded subject to the applicant meeting normal admission requirements;
- 13 Scholarship offers will be made subject to confirmation of academic status;
- 14 Selection criteria will apply;
- 15 All recipients should be of good standing in the community. Scholarships or part thereof may be revoked at the discretion of the Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute.

AWARD PROCESS

- 1 Students will apply on the Outdoor Recreation Scholarship Application Form 2010 and return it to the Avondale Scholarship Office by **31 January 2010**;
- 2 Scholarship applications will only be processed for students who have also submitted an Avondale Application for Enrolment Form;

- 4 Scholarship Applications will be processed during the first week of February and applicants will be notified within 7 days.
- 5 In some cases Avondale will contact a person who knows you well; please provide the name and phone number of two people, such as a school teacher, pastor or employer, who is willing to provide a character reference for you.
