


Peer-reviewed journal articles

What is a peer-reviewed journal article?

A peer-reviewed article is one that has been examined by a panel of experts. You know that a peer-reviewed article is going to be academically sound. Your lecturer may request that you use only peer-reviewed articles in your assignment.

How do I find peer-reviewed journal articles?

It's easy to limit your results to peer-reviewed journals. After you enter your keywords and run your search, select **Peer-reviewed Journals** under **Availability** at the top of the left **Refine my results** column.
