- Nomination is based on excellent academic and clinical performance in the following subjects:

 - NURS22203 Nursing Practice 3
 - NURS22204 Nursing Practice 4
 - NURS33305 Nursing Practice 5
 - NURS33303 Clinical Nursing Elective

Administration of the Prize

The School of Nursing and Health will meet in August/September to review students who meet the selection criteria.
