

VIATEK GROUP BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (ACCOUNTING) PRIZE

Purpose of the Prize

A prize to be known as the Viatek Group Bachelor of Business (Accounting) Prize (Est 2015) may be granted each year to an outstanding first year Bachelor of Business (Accounting) student who has demonstrated overall excellence.

Selection Criteria

The winner shall be determined according to the following criteria:

1. Must be a full-time student in the BBus (Accounting) on a full academic load.
2. Will be selected primarily on performance in the two first-year Accounting units with a weighting of 25/75 between first and second semester grades.
3. All units completed in the course at the time of receiving the prize must be satisfactorily passed.
4. Show diligence and positive attitude to studies and where applicable, quality of service in work experience.
5. Possess excellent relationship with peers, lecturers and university personnel.
6. Demonstrate exemplary citizenship, presentation and professionalism.

Administration of Prize

1. Each year the Prizes Coordinator will confer with the sponsor regarding continuing sponsorship.
2. Any changes to the criteria will be forwarded by the Prizes Coordinator to the Scholarships and Prizes Committee, and once approved, will be uploaded to the Avondale website.
3. Nominations for the prize shall be made by the Head of School in consultation with the lecturers in the Avondale Business School and will include a review of the nominee's academic record.
4. In the event of one or more students equally qualifying for the prize, the prize may be shared between students.
5. The name/s will be presented to the Learning and Teaching Committee for final approval.

Sponsorship

The prize is sponsored by the Viatek Group and shall be provided by way of a pre-paid gift card to the value of \$1000. Avondale will invoice the sponsor for this amount.

Presentation of Prize

The prize will be presented during the year-end graduation ceremony. Prize recipients who are not graduating in the current year will receive their prize at the *Welcome to Avondale* ceremony at the commencement of the next academic year.
