GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA): Avondale calculates its GPA as the sum of each unit grade result multiplied by the credit point value of each unit, divided by the total number of credit points included in the calculation.

COURSE WEIGHTED AVERAGE MARK (WAM): Avondale calculates its WAM as the sum of (unit mark * unit achievable credit point value * unit WAM Weighting) divided by the sum of (unit achievable credit point value * unit WAM Weighting), where the unit WAM Weighting is 0.5 for level 1 units, 1.0 for level 2 units and 2.0 for all other unit levels.
