

HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION PRIZE

Purpose of the Prize

A prize to be known as the Health & Physical Education Prize, recognises enthusiasm and excellence of an Avondale health & physical education student. This prize acknowledges the positive impact that quality health & physical education teachers have on the well-being of their students.

Selection Criteria

To qualify for this prize the recipient must:

1. Exemplify skill, enthusiasm, cooperation, leadership and enjoyment within a wide variety of physical activity contexts,
2. Demonstrate a healthy, active lifestyle,
3. Be a role model for other students in health and physical education,
4. Achieve a consistently sound level of academic performance, and
5. Demonstrate Avondale's values and graduate attributes.

Administration of Prize

1. Each year, the Prizes Officer confers with the sponsor regarding continuing sponsorship.
2. Any changes to the criteria will be forwarded by the Prizes Officer to the Scholarships and Prizes Committee and, once approved, will be uploaded to the Avondale website.
3. The Head of School shall make nominations for the prize in consultation with the Health & Physical Education lecturers and will include a review of the nominee's academic record.
4. In the absence of a student who fits the criteria, a prize may not be granted. If one or more students equally qualify for the prize, the prize may be shared between students.
5. The name/s will be presented to the Learning and Teaching Committee for final approval.

Sponsorship

This prize is sponsored by The Lift Project and shall be provided by way of a pre-paid gift card to the value of \$500. Avondale will invoice the sponsor. In addition to the prize sponsored by The Lift Project, the winning student will also receive a complimentary student membership to the Australian Council for Health, Physical Education and Recreation (sponsored by ACHPER).

Presentation of Prize

The prize will be presented during the year-end graduation ceremony. Prize recipients who are not graduating in the current year will receive their prize at the *Welcome to Avondale* ceremony at the commencement of the next academic year.
